## Instructions for applying for BIP program credits as sociocultural activities

To exchange program activities for sociocultural credits (each degree has a certain number of credits that can be recognized with this type of activities), access the following link and follow the steps indicated:

When you fill the formular you need to upload 3 documents:

- Learning agreement
- Certificate of attendance
- Transcript of record

Provided that you do not have any of the documents listed above, please request them from the International Relations Office.

If the degree does not have optional credits to be recognized as sociocultural activities, which are paid at 50%, the student may recognize them as SET (European Diploma Supplement) credits, which are free.
