Directrices

Los alumnos tienen que venir provistos del DNI, carnet de conducir, pasaporte o carnet universitario UCAM. Si no vienen identificados correctamente no se les permitirá examinarse, salvo que el profesor tenga constancia de su identidad. Durante el examen los documentos identificativos deben estar sobre la mesa en la que cada alumno haga el examen y a la vista.

Los alumnos deben abstenerse de llevar y usar durante el examen el teléfono móvil o cualquier otro dispositivo electrónico y/o con posibilidad de capturar imágenes, o grabar audio/vídeo.

Guidelines

Students must present their NIE, Passport, driving license or UCAM university card. If they come without a correct identification, they will not be allowed to take the exam, excepting that the professor could certified their identity. During the exam, all documents must be discernible on the table where each student is doing the test.

Mobile phones and other different electronic devices with picture capture or video/audio recording are absolutely forbidden.



EXAM REGULATION

1. Students must attend with a valid identification. Failure to comply with this rule will be cause for immediate end and withdrawal of the exam.
2. Only simple pen or marker can be used. More sophisticated markers are not allowed.
3. During an exam, all students must keep their ears uncovered, and hair must be tied back if necessary.
4. Students must keep the exam paper on the table, in front of the body the entire time.
5. Only small written marks will be allowed in the question paper (smaller than 0.5 cm).
6. It is absolutely forbidden to talk (except for the need of translation). Failure to comply with this rule will be cause for immediate end and withdrawal of the exam and an opening of a disciplinary procedure. No doubts about content or concept will be solved.
7. Electronic devices are strictly forbidden, including analogical watches.
